### **Psalm 99:1-9**

- <sup>1</sup> The LORD reigns, let the nations tremble;

- <sup>2</sup> Great is the LORD in Zion; he is exalted over all the nations.
- <sup>3</sup> Let them praise your great and awesome name—he is holy.
- <sup>4</sup> The King is mighty, he loves justice—you have established equity;  
in Jacob you have done what is just and right.
- <sup>5</sup> Exalt the LORD our God and worship at his footstool;  
he is holy.
- <sup>6</sup> Moses and Aaron were among his priests,  
Samuel was among those who called on his name;

- <sup>7</sup> He spoke to them from the pillar of cloud;  
they kept his statutes and the decrees he gave them.
- <sup>8</sup> LORD our God, you answered them;
